Built in Accessibility
Features: speech to text,
text to speech,
magnification, contrast,
text size, mouse speed,
eye control



Alternative Input
Device: ergonomic
mouse, trackball, foot
pedal mouse, head
switch, joystick, eye
gaze, head tracker



Keyboard Shortcuts: Cut/copy/paste, volume controls, screen print



Specialized Software: Zoom Text, JAWS, Dragon Naturally Speaking



Alternative Keyboards: on screen keyboard, one handed keyboard, large keys, high contrast keyboard



Other devices: Braille input/output, stylus, accessible book websites, word prediction
