Assistive Technology for Environmental Adaptation

Assistive Technology for Environmental Adaptation helps people with motor, sensory, cognitive, or learning disabilities access items within the variety of settings in which they live.



Environment Setup: consider placement of items, access to items, lighting, furniture placement, flooring, ramps



Low Tech Items: Built up handles for utensils, toothbrushes, hairbrushes, keys, tactile cues for kitchen appliances, non skid mats, jar opener, magnifying glass, spill proof cup, universal cuff, dressing assists, light switch assists, grabber



Mid Tech Items: Talking timer, talking calculator, currency identifier, caregiver call chime, visual or vibrating alarms, switches, including manual, proximity, Bluetooth, head, foot, joystick, twitch



High Tech Items: Eye tracking, smart homes controls with tablet or phone control or with voice controls for thermostat, lighting, security, and appliances
