Assistive Technology for Hearing helps support individuals who have hearing loss or are deaf.



Consider environmental factors: line of sight, lighting, background noise, visual supports



Telecommunication: amplified, captioned, video, or TTY/TDD phone, relay service



Assistive Listening
Devices: Amplification
with headphone/
microphone, classroom
amplification



Smartphone apps: call captioning, live transcribing, sound amplifier, sign language interpretation



Visual or Vibrating Alerts: clock, baby monitor, fire alarm, doorbell, phone, timer
