Assistive Technology for Recreation helps people with motor, sensory, cognitive, or learning disabilities participate in activities that they enjoy doing during their leisure time.



Board and Card Games: Large print cards, card holder, tactile adapted board games, large dominoes, magnetic board games, talking dice



Television, video, and movies: captioning, audio description services, personal amplification, voice controlled remote



Outdoor Recreation: adapted fishing, hunting, golf, gardening equipment, walking sticks, switch adapted camera



Reading and writing: audiobooks, refreshable Braille display, speech to text, weighted writing utensil



Sports: beeper or jingle ball, bowling ramp, adapted billiards, adapted bicycling, adapted surfing



Music and Art: adapted instruments, large grip paint brushes and other art supplies, drum circle, switch activated tools
