Reading: slant board, guided reading strips, magnifying glass or sheet, hand held magnifier, pen reader, hand held scanner, table top magnifier, text to speech built in accessibility features, text to speech apps, dedicated screen reading programs, audiobooks



Writing: pencil grips, adapted paper, slant board, typing, adapted keyboard, mind mapping graphic organizers, speech to text built in accessibility features, speech to text apps, dedicated speech to text programs



Math: graph paper, manipulatives, abacus, tactile graphics, talking calculator, currency identifier, math apps, dedicated accessible math websites, screen readers, speech to text



Organization: written instructions, daily/weekly/monthly planner, highlighters, checklists, timers, planner apps, checklist apps, audio recorded checklists and planners, alarms, graphic organizers, project management websites
