ATRC's Reuse Program (also called the Assistive Technology Exchange) offers gently used laptops and computers at no cost to individuals with disabilities who can't afford to purchase a new one. Recipients are allowed to keep the laptops/computers for as long as needed. When the equipment is no longer being used, we kindly request that it be returned so that others in need can also benefit from the program.

Please consider donating gently used laptops and computers that you no longer find useful to ATRC. All donated items will be given to residents of Hawaii in need who cannot afford new equipment. Please call, in advance to ensure that a staff member will be available to assist you.

Acceptable Conditions for Donated Laptops & Computers:

1. Physical Condition

- No major cracks or missing parts
- Working screen, keyboard, and ports
- Clean and intact casing

2. Functional Check

- Powers on and boots to desktop
- Holds battery charge (for laptops)
- Working Wi-Fi, keyboard, mouse, and display

3. Minimum Specs

- Windows - Intel Core processor - 8th generation or newer
- Apple Macintosh - from year 2020 or newer
- 8 GB RAM or more
- 120 GB storage or greater (SSD preferred)

4. Software & Security

- Device is wiped of personal data and all security passwords removed
- Free of viruses/malware
- OS installed or installable

5. Age Limit

- Preferably less than 7 years old
- Must support current operating systems
